

## Documents accepted as evidence of English language proficiency at B2 level

**Disclaimer:** the following list is based on the draft Regulation of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of 9 May 2025 on the types of documents certifying proficiency in the language of instruction. The Regulation is expected to be passed by the end of June 2025. Until then, the Maritime University of Szczecin is not in a position to provide definite information on which language documents can be taken into account in the 2025/2026 admissions process.

1. **EXAM BY THE UNIVERSITY:** a certificate of B2, C1 or C2 language proficiency level issued after the examination in the foreign language in question conducted by the university 1) approved by the minister responsible for internal affairs for the purpose of admitting foreigners or not subject to such approval
2. **LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION:** certificate of completing a post primary school outside Poland if the language of instruction was English
3. **ENGLISH PHILOLOGY STUDIES:** Diploma on completing studies in philology in the field of English language or applied linguistics in Poland or abroad (on the condition that the number of hours of English language teaching amounted to at least 500)
4. **POLISH MATURITY EXAMINATION:** Polish maturity examination in English language at extended level with result of at least 60%
5. **IB/EB:** International Baccalaureate Diploma or European Baccalaureate Diploma
6. **SWORN TRANSLATOR:** A document confirming the entry into the Register of Sworn Translators (for English language)
7. **Cambridge** B2 First, C1 Advanced, C2 Proficiency, B2 Business Vantage, C1 Business Higher, Certificate in English for International Business and Trade (**CEIBT**),
8. **TOEFL** – Internet-Based Test (iBT) at least 87 points
9. **TOEIC** at least 700 points
10. European Consortium for the Certificate of Attainment in Modern Languages (**ECL**),

City & Guilds, City & Guilds Pitman Qualifications, Pitman Qualifications Institute – in particular: English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) – First Class Pass at Intermediate Level or above; International English for Speakers of Other Languages (IESOL) – „Communicator” or above; City & Guilds Level 1 Certificate in ESOL International (reading, writing and listening) Communicator or above; Spoken English Test (SET) for Business – Stage B „Communicator” or above; English for Business Communications (EBC) – Level 2 or above, English for Office Skills (EOS) – Level 2,

Education Development International (EDI), London Chamber of Commerce and Industry Examinations (LCCI) – English for Business Level 2 or above; London Chamber of Commerce and Industry Examinations (LCCI) – Foundation Certificate for Teachers of Business English (FTBE); London Chamber of Commerce and Industry Examinations (LCCI) – English for Tourism Level 2 – poziom „Pass with Credit” or „Pass with Distinction”,
14. University of Cambridge ESOL Examinations, British Council, IDP IELTS Australia – in particular: International English Language Testing System **IELTS** – above 6 points,
