Entrance examination at the Maritime University of Szczecin 2025/2026



1. Candidates required to take the exam

- 1.1. Only candidates who apply for admission to undergraduate programmes on the basis of a secondary school **certificate/diploma obtained outside the European Union, OECD, EFTA, Ukraine or China** are required to take the entrance examination.
- 1.2. MUS Admissions staff shall verify your credentials and inform you if you are obligated to take the exam. The information will be sent via the online application system to the e-mail address provided during the candidate's registration.

2. Scope of the exam

The exam will cover the following issues in mathematics:

- 1) operations on algebraic expressions,
- 2) operations on fractions, powers, roots,
- 3) linear function graphs, properties, solving equations and inequalities,
- 4) quadratic function graphs, properties, solving equations and inequalities,
- 5) polynomial and rational equations,
- 6) acute angle trigonometric functions,
- 7) Transforming designs
- 8) solving systems of equations,
- 9) unit conversion.

3. Form of conducting the exam

- 3.1. The exam will be conducted:
 - in Polish for candidates applying for admission to studies in Polish,
 - in English for candidates applying for admission to studies in English.
- 3.2. The exam will be conducted online **on the Moodle platform**. The university will provide your with the data necessary to log in to the platform and instructions. You will have an opportunity of a test connection with the university staff before the exam in order to check your hardware/software capacity.
- 3.3. For the whole duration of the exam you will also be required to connect with MUS staff by means of MS Teams with a webcam and speaker on. In this way, the university will supervise the correct course of the exam.
- 3.4. You will be required to complete the examination on your own and within the specified time.
- **4. The technical requirements** of taking the examination are the following:
 - 4.1. access to a fixed Internet connection with a minimum download speed of 10 Mbps and an upload speed of at least 2 Mbps
 - 4.2. access to a computer equipped with **speakers and a webcam** (built-in or external)
 - 4.3. using one of the **recommended browsers: Chrome, Edge, Firefox or Safari** web browser. The browser must be updated to the latest version, without any plugins installed, incognito access recommended.
 - 4.4. access to the **Microsoft Teams application** from the browser or through a dedicated application. Hardware requirements for Teams are provided by Microsoft: https://learn.microsoft.com/en-us/microsoftteams/hardware-requirements-for-the-teams-app

5. Exam date

- 5.1. The exam will be conducted on 11.07.2025.
- 5.2. If additional admission rounds are opened, the next planned exam dates are 11.08.2025 and 02.09.2025.

6. Exam result

- 6.1. To pass the examination candidates must obtain a minimum of 50% of the possible number of points.
- 6.2. You will be informed about the result of the exam via the online application system to the e-mail address provided during registration.
- 6.3. Only the candidates who successfully passed the examination can participate in the admission process.
